

EASTER IS ... THE PROCLAMATION OF THE RISEN LORD!

On Easter Sunday, beginning with the Easter Vigil and continuing at Masses celebrated throughout the day, the Church proclaims that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead! This Good News is proclaimed in the midst of the Christian people who gather to celebrate the wonder of this great event; "God's victory over the powers of sin and death fulfills the long story of salvation, a history reaching back to creation and stretching to the end of time until the general resurrection from the dead." Christ conquers sin and death through his obedience to the Father, and is raised from the dead to new and eternal life: a gift bestowed on all who believe in him through the power of the Spirit.

Belief in the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead has been based on the witness of the apostles who encountered the Risen Lord after his death and burial. It is this testament that has been passed on from generation to generation by the Christian faithful. The mystery of his resurrection defies explanation: it is accepted based on the gift of faith and trust in the message of the first witnesses of the Risen Lord.

It is in gratitude for this gift of eternal life that the Church gathers on Easter Sunday and every Sunday, the Day of the Resurrection, to give thanks and praise through the celebration of Eucharist. The fifty days of the Easter season, which begins on Easter Sunday, continues the proclamation of the Good News of the resurrection in the context of passion and death, and the stories of the early Church.

The following are some scriptural references to the resurrection and appearances of the Risen Lord. A prayerful reading will lead one into a deeper appreciation of the gift that is given through Christ's death and resurrection.
