Change to Mass Schedule Starts February 22 We will no longer celebrate mass at 7:30 pm on Sunday beginning February 22. This decision has been made after careful consideration of the following.

- We began to celebrate the 7:30 pm Mass with the hopes that it would attract the youth of our parish but this has not been the case.
- The majority of people who have been attending are not members of our parish. This places an additional burden on our Lectors. 
