Infant Baptism

The sacrament of Baptism is the first of three sacraments of initiation into the community of faith. The Church encourages, as the ideal manner of celebrating, that the sacrament be celebrated within the context of Sunday Eucharist. We will now offer the option of having children baptized at various Sunday liturgies. We will alternate the mass of Baptism throughout the year. The next available dates are: March 15, May 3 & July 19.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament can be received after any Mass or by appointment before being hospitalized. Family and friends are welcome.

While the friars make every effort to respond to hospital emergency calls requesting the sacrament, receiving the sacrament *before* going to the hospital is preferable in the event that one of the friars is not available immediately in an emergency.

Priests from the Archdiocese of Toronto are assigned to North York General and Sunnybrook Hospital to provide religious care for patients. To take advantage of this service speak to a nurse or contact the hospital office of Spiritual and Religious Care. Both hospitals also have an on-call Chaplain available 24/7.
