Marriage: the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Contact the Ministry Centre at least one year before the date you would like to be married.


Anointing of the Sick: the sacrament can be received after any Mass or by appointment.

## **Caring for Our Future Campaign - Project Update**

We have completed several of the remaining projects. We repaired the precast concrete beams in the roof of the Parish Centre by cladding them with aluminum. They look great and are now maintenance free. We have replaced all of the incandescent lighting in the Church, Parish Centre & Ministry Centre with LED lighting. This will cut back on future maintenance and is much brighter, energy efficient and great for the environment. As a bonus, we expect to see a decrease in our energy

We are working on replacing the boiler in the church. At the same time, we have been looking at options for providing air conditioning for the church. We have decided not to move forward with the air conditioning project at this time due to the significant cost involved. Once the boiler is replaced and all the projects complete, we will review the air conditioning options if we have sufficient funds.

The renovation in the Parish Centre kitchen has started last July 4th. We will not be able to use the kitchen for up to two months while the contractors are working. The kitchen should be completed by September 1. As a result, Sunday Coffee has been cancelled for the summer. Planning for repairing the outdoor cross continues. We will keep you posted on the progress.
