In July 2013, our parish agreed to sponsor a family from Africa – a mother and her two children; a six year old boy and an eight year old girl. And now they are to arrive in Toronto on July 9! Members of the Resettlement Committee will meet the family at the airport. This would not be possible without the generosity and dedication of the Resettlement Committee and our parish.

An apartment, which Chantal and her children will make into their home, has been rented and cleaned. It is furnished and stocked with the many items which were so thoughtfully selected and donated. The financial donations we received, \$19,049, (slightly under our \$20,000 goal) will support the family during their first year in Canada.

Like thousands of others who have been forced to flee their homes, this family has endured many hardships. We ask you to pray for them and all who seek refuge elsewhere due to persecution because of their race, religion, political belief or social group.
