#### Pope Francis' First Encyclical

Taken from the invocation of St. Francis, "Praise be to you, my Lord", in his Canticle of the Creatures, 'Laudato Si' or 'Praise be to You' is already being called by some, the most important encyclical of the century. Pope Francis doesn't focus on technical solutions to care for the environment. He encourages Christians to embrace an 'ecological conversion'; to make changes in one's everyday lifestyle. More specifically he calls for extreme consumerism to stop. Here are some key points.

Admire nature and all its beauty. This, the Pope hopes, will increase the awareness to care for Mother Nature.

Focus on relationships and not so much on consumerism; everything from spending time with friends, to spending time with one's children.

The Pope calls for Christians to keep their emotions in check; expressing gratitude and not lashing out against others.

Regarding the use of the internet, the Pope reminds Christians that while technological advances have become part of life, it cannot be used as a substitute for human interaction.

There are more practical tips like not using plastic plates or utensils; saving water; taking time to separating one's trash so it's easier to recycle and using appropriate methods to dispose of hazardous waste. And when it comes to recycling, it's not just about paper, but learning to re-use every day items more often, before discarding them. We are encouraged to save energy and not waste resources by limiting the use of air conditioning when it's not needed, and putting on a sweater instead of turning up the heating system. Turning off lights when they are not needed and using public or shared transportation. Then there's also cooking the right amount of food so that it doesn't go to waste.

Pope Francis calls for the caring of plants and a respect for animals for they too have dignity.

The Pope also recognizes the work of consumer advocacy groups, so that the market has more voices than those of just big companies.
