


Transfiguration of the Lord

And Now, A Word from Our Pastor

Through the Sacraments, God continues to transform the Church-the People of God- to be more truly the Body of Christ. In these moments of grace, God deepens our ability to do the work of Christ- to proclaim with our lives and our words that God's Kingdom of mercy has come. Last week, young people of St. Bonaventure Parish formally requested to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on the Solemnity of Pentecost (May 31st).
