In Toronto, estimates of homeless youth range from 900 to 2,000 nightly. The ShareLife-supported Rights of passage program at Covenant House have been active in making a positive difference in the lives of homeless youth on the streets of Toronto. 75% of these youths have been matched with mentors and have also made progress in strengthening their life skills and family relationships, getting them ready for life on their own.
