#### The Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit

**Wisdom** is the gift of knowing the right choices to embrace in order to live a holy life. It helps us to see the "big picture", to put things in their proper perspective, and avoid the things that could lead us away from God.

**Understanding** is the gift of comprehension, or the ability to grasp the meaning of the Scriptures and Tradition of the Church. It also helps us to be tolerant and sympathetic of others. It helps us sense when someone is hurting or in need of compassion.

**Right Judgment, or Counsel**, is the gift of prudence. It helps us to observe, listen, and choose in order to live as faithful follower of Jesus in the events and circumstance of our life. **Courage, or Fortitude**, is the gift that helps us act in the image of Christ, even when the going gets tough. It helps us overcome any obstacles that would keep us from living the faith.

Knowledge is the gift of enlightenment in God's ways. It enables us to be open to the truth, even when it is found in unexpected places.

**Reverence, or Piety**, is the gift of confidence in God rooted in a prayerful and discerning heart.

Wonder and Awe, or Fear of the Lord, is the gift of awareness of God's grandeur, so far beyond us. It moves us to love God, be aware of everyday miracles, and joyfully recognize our dependence upon God.
