

In April 2014, our parish agreed to sponsor a family from Africa — a mother and her two children; a six year old boy and an eight year old girl. To the best of our knowledge they could arrive in Canada in the next 6 to 8 weeks. Our parish will be responsible for supporting this family for a period of one year.

Our parish has \$19,700 remaining from our sponsorship efforts in 2010 when we sponsored a family from Iraq. We will use these funds to support this family and in addition estimate that we will need at least a further \$20,000.
