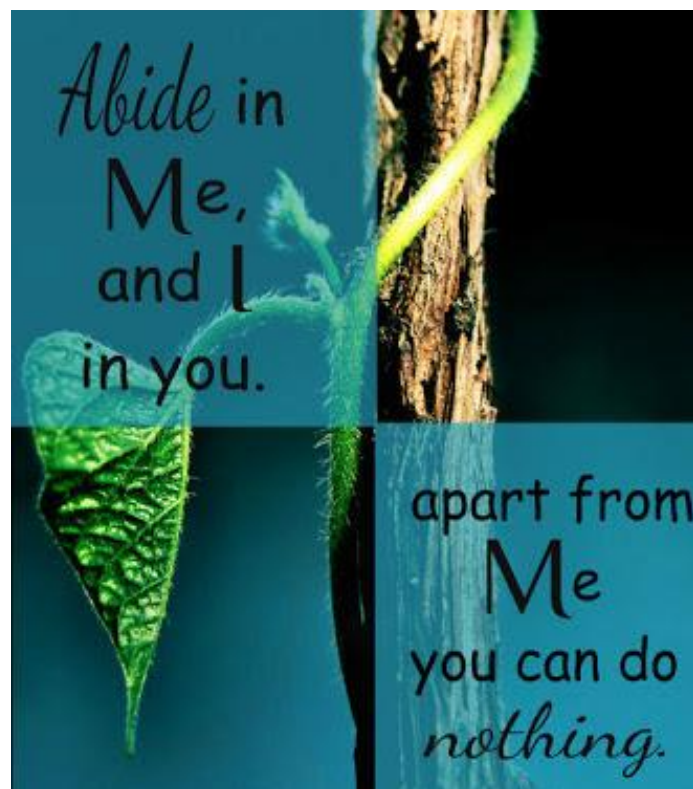

Refugee Resettlement News

In April 2014, our parish agreed to sponsor a family from Africa — a mother and her two children; a six year old boy and an eight year old girl. To the best of our knowledge they could arrive in Canada in the next 6 to 8 weeks. Our parish will be responsible for supporting this family for a period of one year.

Our parish has \$19,700 remaining from our sponsorship efforts in 2010 when we sponsored a family from Iraq. We will use these funds to support this family and in addition estimate that we will need at least a further \$20,000.

Like thousands of refugees, this family has endured many hardships. We need your prayers, time, monetary gifts and household items to provide them with a new beginning. On May 10 we will distribute special collection envelopes which can be used to make a donation on May 24. On May 17 and 24 you will be able to sign up to donate the many household items which this family will need.

Working together, once again our parish family can give a struggling family hope and support to begin a new life. This Mother's Day, we hope you will consider helping another mother and her children by picking up an envelope to make a donation.
